# February 4, 2004 BHHA Board Meeting Minutes

- 1. Minutes from the December 15, 2003 BHHA Board meeting approved.
- 2. The 2004 BHHA Budget, which necessitates a Homeowner Assessment of \$345.00, approved by the Board.
- 3. Discussion on Phase 10 Lien Notices
  - Notices were sent the day after the Annual Meeting Date, January 13, 2004
  - Confirmed interest charges on Phase 10 accounts with a balance due will be waived for 2003
  - Approved interest will accrue on the entire account's balance due for 2004
  - Approved, Management providing Cliff Berry with the necessary documentation requested from his letter
- 4. Discussion about Board Officers and Positions as outlined in the CC&R's
  - Requirement for Board: need only 3 officers; will attempt to fill all 5 positions
  - Reviewed expected duties of President and Secretary
  - Officers not required to be homeowners
  - Necessary to fill 2 Board vacancies with Board appointed one-year terms
  - Board member asked to step down from position if any conflicting interests arise
  - 3 officers may appoint Board members
- 5. Nominations and appointments to fulfill Board vacancies and officer positions
  - President: Robert Perkins
  - Secretary: Kathy Berry
  - Director: Sue Jones
- 6. Review Brick Replacement Project for Barrington and Beacon Hill Bridges, Enhancement of Fairhaven Bridge and Winter Storm Damaged Island Planter brickwork
  - Approved Hempling Masonry's bid for Barrington and Beacon Hill Bridges' brick replacement
  - Management to check that Hempling's bid includes the painting of 33 pillars
  - Request a new bid from Hempling that includes the repairs to the Riverknoll planter
  - Reserve Funds to be used to cover the cost of Barrington and Beacon Hill Bridges' Brick Replacement Project
  - Pursue faulty driver's insurance to cover the cost of damages to Riverknoll's planter
  - Confirmed that all the bridges belong to the City
  - Contact City's Engineers to seek approval for the proposed Fairhaven Bridge Enhancement Design by Sake Reinderserma, BHHA resident volunteer
  - Check the cost difference for inclusion of Barrington Heights' inscription on Fairhaven Bridge Enhancement Design
  - Reserves will also fund future projects such as Fairhaven Bridge Enhancements and Enhanced/Raised Crosswalks
- 7. Discussion on the need for water usage at the Norfolk and Sussex Entrances' Planter from adjacent homeowner
  - No response from these homeowners on the Board's request for permission for water usage
  - Pursue permission by changing the amount of \$75.00 off the homeowner's annual assessment to \$100.00 or see what it takes

- If permission denied, pursue native plantings plan
- 8. Approved the renewal of Showplace's annual landscape contract
- 9. Discussion about the stack of brick pallets located on Wellington Drive
  - Management to notify City about the roadway obstruction and check City's regulations on Sport Court lights
  - Follow up with a letter to homeowner if necessary

### 10. Discussion on Audit

- Management reported that BHHA Bylaws require an audit every year but the past Boards had chosen to have an audit every other year
- Approved an Audit since it has been 2 years since the last audit.
- 11. Report on the utilities' easement on the City's land located on Manchester
  - Over 15 utility accesses at this location
  - City is not willing to remove any
  - Investigate the possibility of plantings to conceal utilities
- 12. Discussion about BHHA Directory
  - Request to include BHHA Regulations/Guidelines in the Directory
  - Solicit advertisement sponsors to defray the directory's costs
  - Check for an existing database established for 2002-2003 Directory
  - Bill Giller, BHHA homeowner, volunteered to create a database if one did not exist
- 13. Discussion about Showplace's landscape enhancement proposal
  - Request another company's bid for Bark Dust (including the darkest color available) installment in the planter beds.
  - Approved the removal of the Rhododendrons obscuring the view of Barrington Height sign
  - Seek Jim and Sherri King's advice on plantings for Rhododendron planter and other planters
  - Approved plantings for Riverknoll Island, Rivernoll Court Island and Wellington Bridge
  - Approved Cranefly control, moss control, aeration for lawns and tree pruning

#### 14. Discussion about Lighting

- Reported that the light pole at 3355 Barrington needs replacement and the globe at Wellington needs replacement
- Light sensor installed on main tree at entrance
- Agreed that only the main tree at entrance would remain lit all year
- Lights on all other trees will remain on tree but will only be lit for the holiday season
- Barrington/Beacon Hill Island will keep the floodlights on tree
- Sue Jones volunteered to assist in re-aiming the floodlights' light projection
- 15. Discussion on Sue Jones Traffic Report
  - Reviewed the traffic statistics acquired from Barrington Drive traffic flow study by the City and a previous study prior to Tanner Stonegate and Fairhaven Bridges
  - Presented proposal for Converting Tanner Stonegate Bridge to a Pedestrian Only Bridge which would be submitted to Barrington Hidden Tanner Neighborhood Association (BHTNA) by the BHHA Board
  - Board agreed to solicit Barrington Heights' homeowners on this proposal and will authorize signing this petition unless there is opposition
